Abbott Animal Hospital then reserve the right to care, custody, and control of the pet.

Feeding and Care: We offer Science Diet dry food twice daily to all boarding pets. Dogs are exercised outside on our nature trails frequently throughout the day. Cats are handled and petted several times daily. There will be an additional cost for supplemental food for inappetent or sick pets.

All boarding pets must have current vaccinations. DA2PPC, Bordetella and Rabies are required for dogs. FVCRP and Rabies are required for cats. If your pet requires vaccinations or you would like to have your pet examined by a doctor while boarding, please make your request or describe the symptoms your pet has.

Please check one regarding treatment of your pet during boarding.

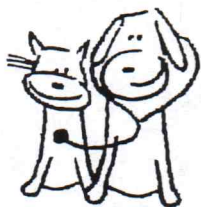

At Abbott Animal Hospital we strive to provide the best possible care for our patients. All pets undergoing surgical procedures will receive a full examination, ear cleaning, and nail trim. For all applicable procedures, we provide an anti-anxiety pre-surgical sedative and two different types of pain medications post-operatively. We use the newest generation of gas anesthetic, Sevoflurane, and monitor carefully our patients' vital signs with a pulse oximeter. Of course, extra tender loving care is always included.
